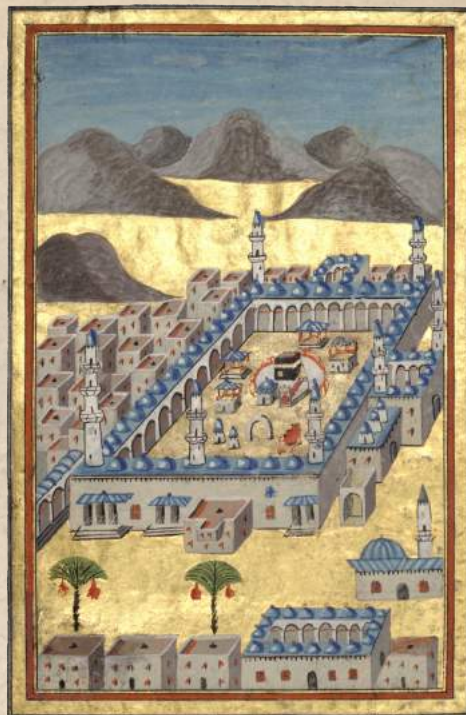
University Library in Bratislava is the largest and oldest research library in Slovakia. Since its foundation in 1919 it has been a major influence on generations of our leading scientists, teachers and writers, and other personalities in the social and cultural life of Slovakia. Library's collections include nearly three million documents including 450 incunabula and many other rare books from all over the world. University Library in Bratislava is the most visited library and its three attractive historical buildings are located in the centre of the capital city of the Slovak Republic.

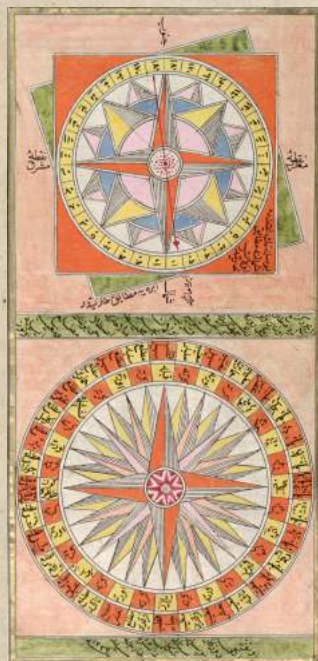


B A Š A G I Ć C O L L E C T I O N





University Library in Bratislava purchased a remarkable personal book collection owned by **Safvet beg Bašagić** from Sarajevo (Bosnia) in 1924.



The collection currently comprises **598** manuscripts in **284** volumes, of which **393** are in Arabic, **114** in Turkish and **88** in Persian. The whole collection has been professionally catalogued and restored.

„**Bašagić Collection**“ of Islamic manuscripts was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List „Memory of the World“ in 1997.
